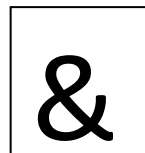
A bus is scheduled to take you to your polling place on Tuesday, November 8 at 10 am.

Treasurer's Report: Elaine Gemuenden There's \$1,273.29 in the entertainment fund. Fund raiser coming soon!

Management: Mara Krinke Apartments and townhomes are full and we have a healthy waiting list...get involved and meet your new neighbors! MoBility4All contract will end Oct. 31. Stark Transportation and later, Edwards RideCare will be available for rides within 12 miles. Arrowhead bus tickets also available by the end of the week. New townhomes: The scope and planning of the project will be finalized with an eye to start development in the spring. Projects: 15 townhomes got new water heaters; 24 townhomes got new garage aprons; townhomes that didn't get a new roof last year are getting new roofs and should be completed in the next 2 weeks; security camera wiring is being completed this week in the apartment building, with cameras going in in November.
