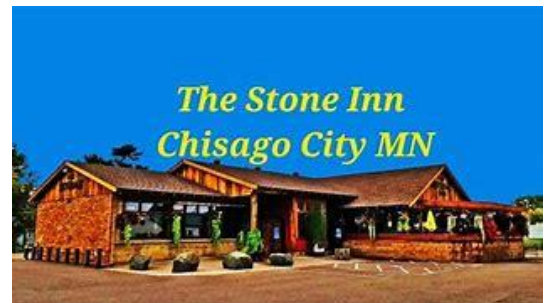

## POINT PLEASANT HEIGHTS RESIDENT MEETING MINUTES – Tuesday, October 17, 2023, 3 pm

Meeting called to order by Phil Terrill.

**News Report by Phil Terrill:** (1) No new residents recognized this month (not all present). Gary and Priscilla Fladland, recent move-ins, attended the tenant meeting for the first time since moving in and introduced themselves. (2) Upcoming in November will be election of officers. If anyone is interested in being on the ballot, please let Phil know. (3) We will also be having a fund drive in order to raise money for the tenant's treasury that pays for the monthly entertainment provided for the birthday celebrations. We will be seeking a \$25 donation from residents to help in that regard. (4) In December, the tenant council will host a craft sale where residents and their friends/family may rent a table to sell crafts and/or baked goods. Proceeds of the table rental will go back to the tenant treasury to help with the entertainment fund. (5) Welcome back to Juli Almqvist (office staff) from her month's long vacation. We missed her!

**Treasurer's Report by Rose Wisdorf:** The treasury balance for October is \$1,132.24; reflects \$100 cost for the September birthday celebration entertainment and a \$3 service charge to the checking account.

**Office staff reports given by Juli:** (1) Juli mentioned that there isn't too much to report on other than that Mara is out on personal leave until the end of November. (2) Ed (Maintenance) is out on an emergency call, so no report from him. Ed mentioned that if apartment residents are having difficulty figuring how to run their heating system, please fill out a work request form, and he will get to you. (3) Addy from the Ecumen home office is coming to PPH two days a week to fill in on some of Mara's duties while she is out.

**Kitchen Report by Jeannie** – Jeannie has been busy filling in for some of Mara's duties while she is on leave, as well as working with the new cook who was recently hired. Repairs to walls by kitchen are being made after the new dishwasher malfunctioned, causing water damage.
